

Path Criteria

Path proposals are due November 28, 2018.

In addition to addressing the criteria below, please also include a brief overview, no more than a paragraph, describing what the path covers, and what sets it apart.

A path should have a coherent 5-year curriculum with the following elements:

1. ___ calendar of all courses/programs in the path, with faculty commitments for each
 - ___ foundational work available annually
 - ___ advanced work with clear prerequisites available annually
2. ___ sufficient numbers of regular faculty to support foundational and advanced work, while allowing faculty to meet their other commitments (to first-year teaching and team-teaching) and allowing the path to absorb events such as retirements, leaves, and sabbaticals; the proposal may also include EWS offerings that have historically been part of the path's area(s) of study.
3. ___ opportunities for students to pursue broad, interdivisional study, either through interdivisional work within the pathway, or by designing the path so students have time to pursue work in other divisions.
4. ___ convener(s) for the first 2-year cycle (Winter '19 - Spring '20)
